

Tourism Rosetown



Purpose of the Organization: To promote and encourage Tourism in Rosetown and surrounding area.

Participants: All ages, genders and ability levels.

Programs and Services: The Tourism Center opens the middle of May and closes the end of August. It is located at the end of Main Street where one can enjoy flower gardens, a picnic area and mini-golf. We distribute information (maps, events, sight-seeing, souvenirs) and hard ice cream cones. We also provide someone with contact people (museum, library, Town Office, Realtors, etc.) A map of the historical walk is freely provided and tourists are encouraged to take this walk and view the mural and legend of Rosetown's early years on the wall of Pharmasave.

Special Events: You may buy a space and have your name placed on the Community Xmas Card at the Post Office. Floats are entered in Rosetown parades and we have partnered with Communities in Bloom to beautify the Town. We man a table at the Community Garage Sale every fall and have a BBQ on the grounds some time in August. Many birthday parties are hosted by our summer staff.

Accomplishments: With the Communities in Bloom, we have had the Town warehouse on Hwy 7, painted as well as the Tourism building. We also sell advertising to buy a page in the annual Destination Saskatchewan booklet, distributed by the Star Pheonix every Spring. A Tourism booklet is published every two years. Local businesses buy ads in it which enables us to provide these books at no charge to tourists and local residents. We consider this booklet to be one of the best in the province! Our board records hundreds of volunteer hours each year - probably among the top three of any organization in Rosetown.
